Under 1 Mo	Examination: UNCLOTHED, includes History, Physical, Dental (assessment of gums and mouth), Nutrition, Anticipatory Guidance, Development, Tobacco Exposure, Psycho-social, TB Risk Assessment, Height, Weight, Head Circumference and Immunizations	1 Mo
1-2 Mo	Examination, as above	2 Mo
3-4 Mo	Examination, as above	2 Mo
5-6 Mo	Examination, as above	2 Mo
7-9 Mo	Examination, as above, Hgb/Hct	3 Mo
10-12 Mo	Examination, as above, (12 months - <i>Initial Lead Test, & Dental Assessment/Referral to Dental Home.</i>)	3 Mo
13-15 Mo	Examination, as above, Lead Test if needed, Hgb/Hct Dental Assessment/Referral.	3 Mo
16-23 Mo	Examination, as above, Lead Test if needed, Dental assessment/Referral.	6 Mo
2 Yrs	Examination, (Head Circumference Not Needed After Age 2), TB Risk Assessment, Repeat Lead Test , Hgb/Hct, calculate & graph Body Mass Index (BMI) Percentile, Dental Assessment/Referral.	1 Yr
3 Yrs	Examination, Blood Pressure, TB Risk Assessment, Lead Test if never had one at 2 yrs or later, Mental Health Assessment, Hgb/Hct, BMI Percentile, Vision, Hearing, Dental Assessment/Referral.	1 Yr
4-5 Yrs	Examination, BP, TB Risk Assessment & PPD, Lead Test if never had one at 2 yrs or later, Mental Health Assessment, Hgb/Hct, BMI Percentile, (Glucose, Cholesterol, if needed), Vision, Hearing, Urine, Dental Assessment/Referral.	1 Yr
6-8 Yrs	Examination, BP, Mental Health, TB Risk Assessment, Hgb/Hct, BMI Percentile, (Glucose, Cholesterol, if needed), Vision, Hearing, Urine, Dental Assessment/Referral.	1 Yr
9-12 Yrs	Examination, BP, Mental Health, TB Risk & PPD, Hgb/Hct, BMI Percentile, (Glucose, Cholesterol, if needed), Vision, Hearing, Urine, Dental Assessment/Referral.	1 Yr
13-16 Yrs	Examination, BP, Mental Health, TB Risk & PPD, if needed, Hgb/Hct, BMI Percentile, (Glucose, Cholesterol, if needed), Vision, Hearing, Urine, Dental Assessment/Referral, Pelvic/PAP, Sexually Transmitted Disease Testing If Sexually Active.	1 Yr
•17-18 Yr- Non-MC •17-20 Yr- MC	Examination, BP, Mental Health Assessment, TB Risk Assessment, Hgb/Hct, BMI Percentile, (Glucose, Cholesterol, if needed), Vision, Hearing, Urine, Dental Assessment/Referral, Pelvic/PAP, Sexually Transmitted Disease testing If Sexually Active.	1 Yr

Medically Necessary Interperiodic Health Assessments (MNIHA):

- **Foster children need an exam within 30 days of initial placement and every year due to being at high risk for health problems.**
- Other children can have annual exams if needed for a **Camp or Sports Physical**.
- An exam can be billed for an **Extended Visit** if the child has not been seen for 2 Yrs or there are extensive educational needs of the client or parent/guardian.

Note: An explanation must be included on the PM 160, for ALL of the above reasons.

- **Routine lead testing** is to be done at 12 months and 2 Yrs of age. A blood lead test should also be done if the child has not been tested between the ages of 2 and 6 years of age. (Adapted from the CHDP Health Assessment Guidelines, 3 Feb 97). An Interperiodic exam can be done for a child with an elevated Blood Lead Level at the time of the first repeat lead test for the purpose of education/anticipatory guidance.
